Come on out and meet our horses and learn about our wonderful Programs.

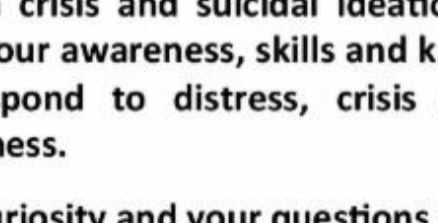

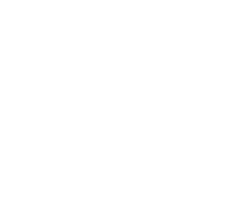
